This program is hosted by Mystic & Noank Library and co-sponsored by the Groton Public Library, Otis Library, and Stonington Free Library.



THE WAGES OF LOVE: POEMS by Christie Max Williams






Join author Christie Max Williams as he shares a debut collection of poems exploring moments of inquiry, affirmation, passion, remorse, compassion and joy.




